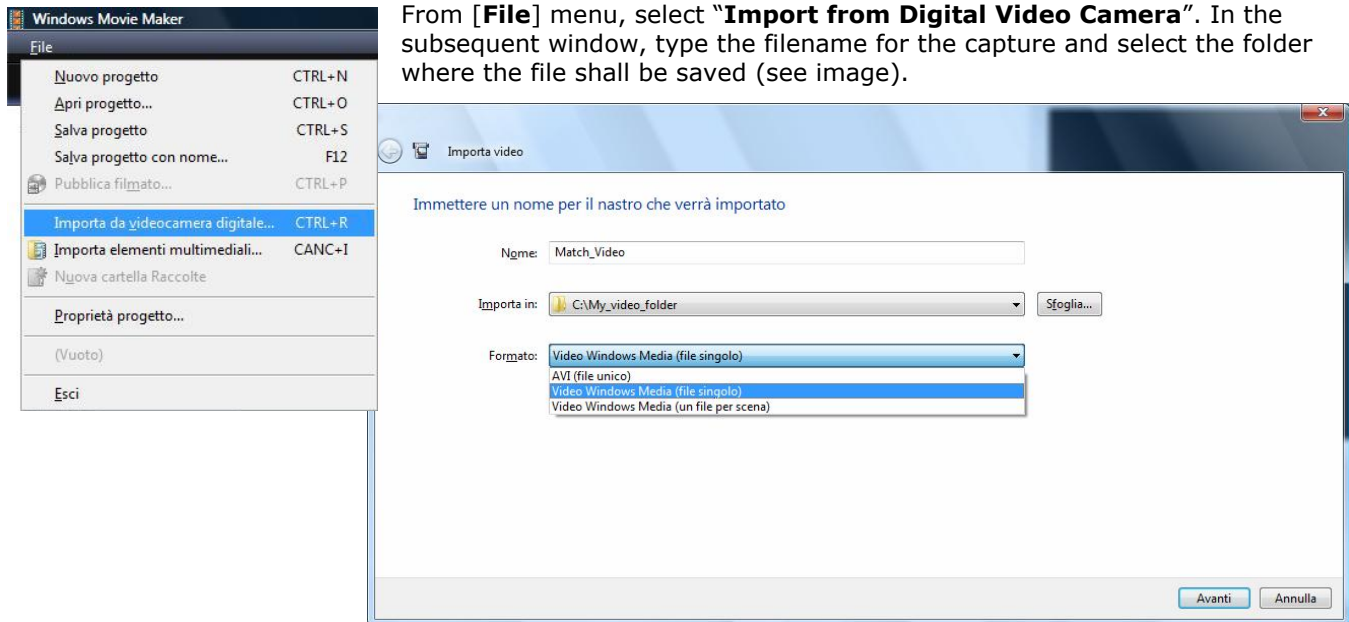


Tutorial Video Capture through Windows Movie Maker (Windows VISTA)

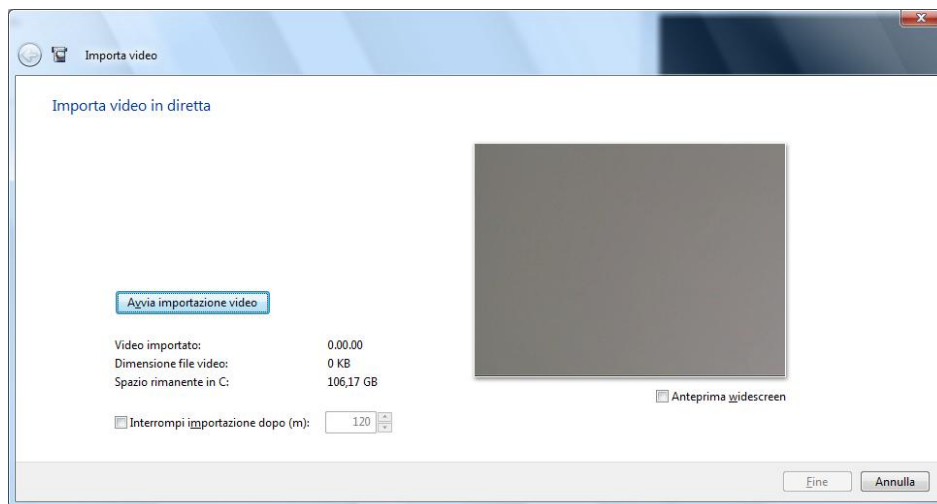
Connect the Digital Video-Camera to the PC through the Firewire port (IE1394) making sure to turn on the video-camera.

Launch Windows Movie Maker program from [Start] then [Programs] ▶ Windows Movie Maker

From [File] menu, select "Import from Digital Video Camera". In the subsequent window, type the filename for the capture and select the folder where the file shall be saved (see image).



After filename and destination folder have been set, select Windows Media Video (single file) as format and then click on [Next>].



IMPORTANT: before continuing the process, make sure to have enough disk-space to carry out the complete capture of the video.

To begin the capture, click on "Start Capture". To stop the capture click on "Stop Capture". It is possible to specify the time length of the capture by entering the number of minutes and enabling the check **Stop Capture after (min.)**

At the end of the capturing phase, quit the program and the AVI non-compressed file will be ready to be compressed into **VideoSharing** environment or it will be ready to be imported into **Data Video** as Custom match.
